Art of Coaching - getting the kid in the right place - to use their skill set

Do your job like the floor mop guy at Ole Miss.

Taking over a new program - Brentwood Academy

Used all of June to put in Offensive System - Chemistry of returning team was already there.

Drills - Practice

Offensive Rebound Coverage - Defensive Transition

- Half-Back & Full-Back Send 3 to the glass
- 5 on 0 set to 5 on 5 to 5 on 5

Starts-Stops-Turns with Defensive Pressure

- Count/Chart Deflections
- Working on Pass Fake & Pass

Always includes skill development throughout the season.

One Offensive Concept per day - don't put too much in all at once. Layer it and add to it each day.

Combines Varsity/JV guys early in season - split up once football guys are available.

Define Winning - What does it look like to you?

- Disciple of Christ first
- Wanna be a Christian that coaches...not a coach that is Christian.
- Be humble and treat people right
- Would you rather win every game or sacrifice all these things?

Team Verse - Seek first the kingdom of God...

Celebrate each other's victories...Enter into each other's struggles.

Teach Players to pay it forward.

When people watch your team play...they leave inspired.

Dealing with a Toxic Player

- Who's running your locker room
- Is US helping you or YOU hurting the team?
- Is it time to go?
